

Techlab 2 Movie Station

....the real story about techlab movie

Goal: make a 3 minute video and burn it to a dvd.

- Must be filmed entirely in the techlab
- Topics:
 - The stations of techlab two documentary.
 - The students of techlab two
 - The mystery of techlab two
 - Techlab Two: the Art Movie
 - ...a creative story of your own using the techlab as your set, actors, soundstage.
- Must use Final Cut Pro to edit the film.
- DVD must have at video, sound, and multiple menu buttons.

Step One: The Shoot

- Use the provided camera...
- You may only film inside the techlab.
- Take about 12 minutes of RAW footage.
- Include:
 - 25% Extreme close-ups (muc)
 - 25% over the Shoulder (ots)
 - 25% Wide establishing shots
 - 25% art, interesting, and tricky shots.
 - Include 30 secs in front of a green screen.
 - Include ONE in-camera special effect

Step Two: Capture to Computer

- Name & save your project
- Set “easy setup” to dv-ntsc 48
- Log & capture your tape to computer
 - Set the scratch drive properly
 - Name your log& cap so it does not show as “untitled” in the documents cap scratch file.

Step Three: Edit using FCPro

- Must get down to a 3 minute film tops.
- Must make at least 4 subclip/sequences and export them to use for the dvd menu part of this assignment.

Step Four: Add Titles

- Use Livetype software
 - Opening titles
 - Closing credits
 - Name labels on interviewed students

Step Five: Add Audio

- Must have some music authored by your team using Garageband.
- May have .wav music imported from cd's or Itunes but this music may not be longer than 20 secs each.
- Must use Soundtrack program to add some sound fx to your movie.

Step Six: Render & export

- Make sure everything is saved and rendered.
<sequence><render><all> before exporting.
- Export your movie in two ways:
 - As a quicktime dv ntsc for your dvd
 - As an mp4 for my jump drive to view
- Export a number of small clips for your dvd menu
 - No longer than 10 sec each
 - As mp4's so they don't take up much space.

Step Seven: DVD Construction

- Use IDVD to make a DVD.
 - Must have some video playing on the menu.
 - Must have multiple menu buttons.
- Allow at least 30 minutes to burn your DVD.
- Please honor your family & friends by showing them your great movie!
